  - b) English 60%
  - c) Physical Science 60%

- 6) Candidates who do not meet the criteria an (1) to (5) above will be disqualified.
- 7) Candidates must attend all classes and write all exams and tests as and when required to do so.
- 8) Candidates must be available for an interview and for an assessment.
- 9) Candidates must apply online via our website.
- 10) The directors of the Growth Group of Companies will have the final decision on the awarding of the above bursaries.
